You may be required to prove that you mailed your protest on or before the June 8 deadline; therefore, we recommend that you retain proof of mailing. If you wish to protest in person, present to the Assessor's office your estimate of property value as of June 30, 2024, and a copy of any documentation that you believe supports a change in the classification and/or valuation of your property. You must appear in the office of the County Assessor no later than June 8, § 39-5-122(2), C.R.S.					
To preserve your appeal rights, your protest must be either postmarked or received by the Assessor no later than June 8 - after such date, your right to protest is lost.						
The Assessor must mail you a Notice of Determination on or before the last working day in June .
